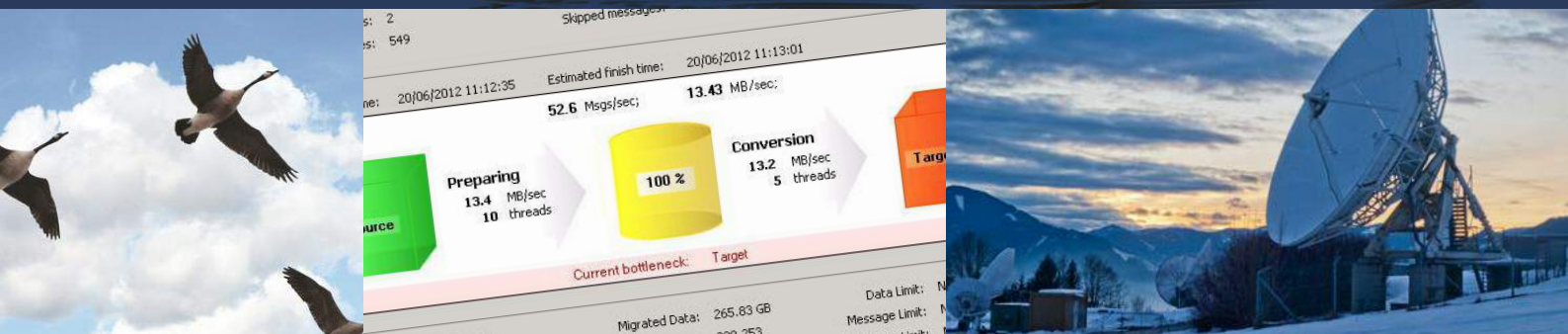


Migrating archives to Enterprise Vault



Swiss Broadcasting Company Consolidates its Email Archives

SRG SSR, Switzerland's largest television and radio corporation is to migrate 18 million email messages into Symantec Enterprise Vault.

The migration is the final step in a consolidation project to bring together email records from multiple archive platforms across SRG's subsidiaries, including earlier versions of Symantec Enterprise Vault and EMC EmailXtender for Microsoft Exchange.

Messaging and migration experts Essential Computing will be working in conjunction with Swiss-based Informatio GmbH on the project.

The Essential Exchange Archive Migration Service is designed to protect an organisation's existing email archives as they upgrade their archive or switch to a new email archive platform.
